Application Procedure

Please contact the International Office for inquiries about application procedure for exchange students. The International Office will email the required document and forms that need to be completed and sent back to us as well as all the important information concerning exchange program.

Language Requirements

Generally, all the courses are held regularly in Indonesian language. We only offer limited courses taught in English. For those who do not have Indonesian language competency, UNS offers BIPA Program (*Bahasa Indonesia bagi Penutur Asing*/Indonesian Language for Non-Native Speakers), a program which gives access for foreigners who are interested in learning Indonesian language.

To attend courses delivered in English, students must demonstrate proficiency in the English language by having a TOEFL score of at least 450 for those majoring in science and 500 for those majoring in social studies. TOEFL scores are valid only if dated within two years of the program's start date.

Accommodation

Based on students' preferences, there are a number of options for housing close to campus.

1. University's Dormitory

UNS students' dormitory is located approximately 3 km from the main campus and could be reached by public or private transportation. The dormitory is equipped with shared kitchens and shared/private bathrooms. The rate for the dormitory in the last academic year is about 350.000 IDR per month. (1 USD is approximately 14,500 IDR)

- 2. Rent from Private Landlords
 - House for Rent
 - Several students rent and share one unfurnished house (although few may have simple beds and desks/chairs). This type of house typically has 2-5 rooms and shared garage, living room, bathroom, kitchen, and other facilities of the house. The rate varies starting from approximately 10,000,000 IDR per year.
 - Room for Rent
 - Many landlords rent a house consisting of 10 or more furnished bedrooms. Students live together in the house, usually sharing bathrooms (although now many bedrooms are equipped with a private bathroom) and kitchen. The rent period is 6 months or 12 months. The rate varies starting from approximately 3,000,000 IDR for 6 month.



Health Insurance

All admitted students are entitled to health care provided by UNS Medical Center. In addition to the Medical Center, Solo has excellent medical facilities and services that are considerably affordable. However, it is also advisable that exchange students have a valid international health insurance/.

Accreditation

UNS is accredited A by BAN-PT (The Indonesian National Accreditation Board for Higher Education) and ranked third among higher education institutions in Indonesia according to the accreditation conducted in 2014.

In addition, UNS was awarded 2 stars by QS Stars

Credit Transfer System

UNS provides official academic transcript for every student attending courses and taking credits in our university. UNS uses a numerical grading system on a 5-point scale which is used for the calculation of a grade point average (GPA). The numerical grades are considered equivalent to letter grades as follows:

Tuition and Fees

If based on a signed official agreement, an exchange student will be eligible for a waiver of tuition and the registration fees. However, students must be responsible for their own living cost while staying in Indonesia.

Other Scholarship under Bilateral Agreement

Scholarship opportunities for incoming students can be decided and entered into specific Activity Agreement based on the forms of implementation mutually agreed upon by both institutions.
